WHAT DOES Portfolio Title, LLC (PT) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and address(es) ■ Account balances and payment history ■ Loan information and information concerning real estate transactions
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons PT chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does PT protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does PT collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- provide contact information or a government-issued ID
- provide it to an agent or provide it to a lender
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We collect your personal information from third parties such as credit bureaus and real estate agents.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on the account--unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Affiliates may include Campbell & Brannon* and Home Real Estate, LLC.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Nonaffiliates may include financial service providers (e.g., consumer banks and insurance companies) and non-financial service providers (e.g., technology, legal, and other firms).*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *N/A - we do not have joint marketing agreements with nonaffiliated financial companies.*
